For Harold,

This afternoon Mr. McCloy
phoned to me that we had
purchased 121 shares at
\$115 flat and that delivery
will be made next week.
I tried to reach you by phone
but you had already left. I
think this is not in accord with your
understanding with you please
telephone to me tomorrow?

Mr. Hardy telephoned to
me late this afternoon and said
that he had been unable to make
any progress and that he saw
nothing to be gained by my
going to Washington tomorrow. He
says that, when we do go to Washington
on Monday, the thing to do is to
get all the policy-making officials
together and to find a solution
then and there. That's that! I'm
sorry it has worked out this way!
