Dear Mr. Horsewell,

I apologise for the delay in writing to you after the visit which Mr. J. A. Mallett and I paid you on 9th. March. You asked us to let you have any published information we issue regarding the various rayon staple fibres. For your information I am sending herewith technical booklets on 'Vincel' (Courtaulds polynosic fibre), 'Sarille' (fine denier crimped rayon fibres), 'Durafil' (high tenacity, high abrasion resistant fibre), and 'Eylan' (our carpet fibre). Unfortunately, I haven't a copy of the 'Fibro' manual to hand which refers in general to our standard fibre; however, I am attempting to obtain one and will pass this onto you in due course. As you will appreciate, these are all written with a textile bias and only a little amount of the information therein will really be relevant to your interests.
