 BILL NUMBER: SB 1840 (Companion HB 2516)

ISSUE: Employee Termination  
 SUMMARY: Would prohibit employees from being fired because they refused to participate in, or remained silent about, illegal activities. An employee who would be fired in violation of the provisions of this bill would have a cause of action against employer and would be able to receive attorney fees and costs in addition to any other damages.
