Project Title: Smoking Tests of Cigar Tobacco from the CDA
L'Assomption Experimental Farm, 1970 Crop.

Object: To evaluate the subjective smoking properties of
cigar tobaccos from various plant breeding,
topping and spacing and curing experiments
conducted at L'Assomption.

Personnel Involved: G.W. Boswall, H. Roubicek, R.R. Smith, S. Webster.

Prior to 1974 Subjective Evaluation of the Topping and Spacing
experiment was completed and some statistical
analyses of data performed. The final report has
not, however, been compiled.

Requests for the processing of tobaccos and the
manufacture of cigars were made covering the
Varietal and Hybrid experiments.

First Half 1974 The Varietal and Hybrid cigars were forwarded
to the L'Assomption Experimental Farm for subjective
smoking tests.

Second Half 1974 Pending completion of the subjective evaluation of the
1971 Crop (T0758) Topping and Spacing experiment,
statistical analysis of the combined data from two years
will be undertaken.
