Improvement on U.K. 938,860. Tobacco is showered downwards onto an air-pervious band by gravity through a chute which terminates in a narrow trough, the depth of which increases progressively in the direction of travel of the band. The tobacco is pulled into the trough and towards the band by means of a differential air pressure.
