Would ban smoking in enclosed public places, including restaurants, elevators, public transportation, retail stores, commonuse areas such as restrooms and hallways, service lines, public facilities, sports arenas, and businesses patronized by the public such as banks, and laundromats. Bans smoking in the workplace. Exempts bars and retail tobacco stores. Signs prohibiting smoking must be posted.

Bans smoking in enclosed public and workplaces. Prohibits smoking within 10 feet of entrances. Retailers must obtain a license to sell tobacco and tobacco sales to minors are prohibited. Requires all sales to be vendor-assisted.

*Amendment restricts the sale and use of tobacco products.

Would require that all retailers have a license to sell tobacco products. Would adopt the definition of tobacco from state statutes. Would provide for provisions regarding licensure; ann annual license fee of \$100, to be deposited in the Multnomah County Youth Tobacco Account. Would provide merchant education opportunities, with a due diligence waiver for good faith efforts. Would stipulate that photo identification be required of all buyers of tobacco must be presented and examined unless retailer has other "conclusive basis" to know the buyer is over 18. Would provide for progressive sanctions for violation of license or failure to obtain and maintain a license. Penalties for dealers wo sell tobacco to minors are as follows: 1st offense: licensee shal be given written notification of provisions for penalties to be levied int he event of additional violations; 2nd offense: licensee shall be fined \$100 and have license suspended for 30 days; 3rd offense: licensee shall be fined \$250 and license suspended for nine (9) months.
