SUBJECT: DIET PILOT STUDIES

I have attached a copy of a report which discusses the experimental justification for moving the DIET expander/dryer feed point. As you know, because of contractual and logistical considerations, it will be necessary to make this physical change at a convenient date sometime after start-up of first shift operation. I feel that you will agree that the potential benefits to be gained by this modification outweigh the scheduling inconveniences.

It is our belief that much of the information contained in this report goes beyond Philip Morris' understanding in this area. As such, I would like to ask that you limit the distribution of this report to key personnel and restrict discussion of its contents to within PMO.
